He entered the energy industry in 1975. Having postponed his formal education to gain valuable experience with Brown & Root on major North Sea projects in Holland, Norway and Scotland, Alan returned to his studies graduating in 1983 with a BSc (Hons) in Civil Engineering from Trent Polytechnic, Nottingham.

Much of his early professional experience was gained internationally in Europe and SE Asia, representing major Operators (Shell, Atlantic Richfield) and Contractors in engineering and project management positions in the execution of large projects.

In 1993 he graduated from Aston Business School with a Masters degree in Business Administration.

Prior to founding Falcon Global in 2000, Alan was a consultant and interim manager with a Norwegian drilling and exploration company, leading successful claims and cost recoveries on projects for the conversion of semi-submersible drilling rigs. From 1996 to 1997, he held the position of Business Manager for the eastern region at Brown & Root-AOC in Aberdeen and Gt Yarmouth, then was head hunted to become Managing Director of KYE Ltd, a UK-based contracting company. While at KYE, Alan identified a number of brand opportunities to elevate the company's status and add value.

Alan is a Chartered Engineer since 1985, and served as Past Chairman of the Institute of Marine Engineering, Science & Technology (IMarEST), East of England branch from 2002 to 2003.

In 2005, in recognition of the company's outstanding export achievements, Falcon Global was East of England Winner of UK Trade & Investment's International Trade Awards.
